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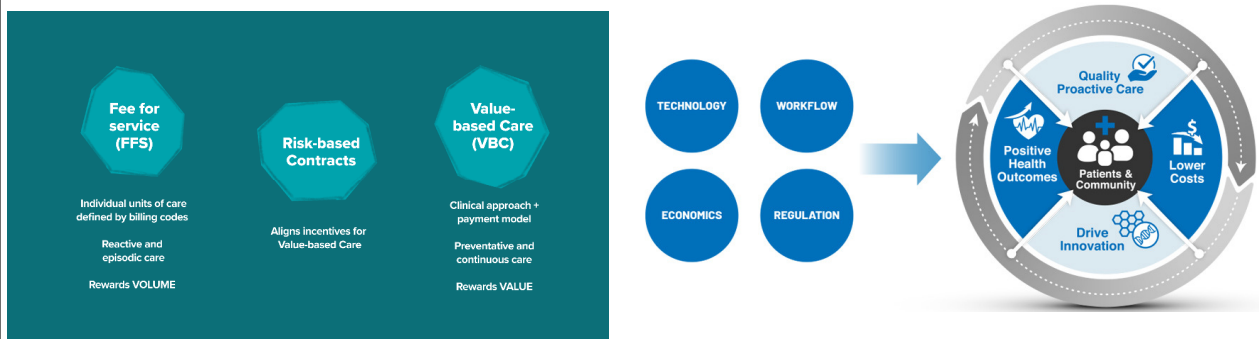

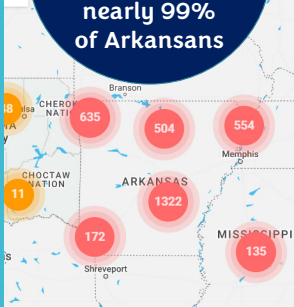

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Direct Secure Messaging (SM)

- Direct Trust Secure Messaging lets users share clinical information— such as clinical care summaries, referrals, transitions of care documents, immunization records, lab results and images—through secure, encrypted email exchange with other providers.
- Most importantly, other providers can send clinical information instantly, so providers have it before the patients arrive.

- Goal to reduce repeat acute care events
- Quickly identifies patients who have had a change in clinical status
- Aids in providing education for appropriate ER usage
- Helps in identifying high risk patients who frequent ER
- Report includes the attending provider to encourage collaboration between the PCP and hospitalist
